for platform musicians & vocalists

*This document will provide you with an overview and help answer any questions you might have about the opportunities available in the areas of instrumental and vocal ministries.*

**Band:** The Worship Bands are made up of musicians who play for our weekend services and other special worship events when the need arises. These musicians are experienced and have giftedness in a specific instrumental field.

**Vocals:** the Vocal Teams are made up of people who are experienced and gifted signers who have a passion to lead people into a deep worship relationship with Jesus and to see His church grow. Auditions are required to fill a position.

## **Style**

The style of delivery and ministry (pretty much across the board) is one of relevance. We always work to be current and up-to-date in our style and presentation. You might be a prodigy on the piano but only have strength in playing show tunes or the old hymn style. We obviously would be looking for more of a pop/mainstream background.

## **Salvation**

One's salvation and growth as a Christian are very important when it comes to serving on the platform. Anyone can audition, but you must be a growing Christian in order to progress further in becoming a part of this ministry.

## **Time Commitment**

Before you audition, be aware of the time commitment involved with the music teams. There are rehearsal times during the week as well as rehearsals before our weekend services, not to mention the leading during the services.

If you are scheduled for a weekend, you are required to be at all rehearsals.

People that are scheduled for a weekend get a song set list up to 4 weeks in advance. It is up to the individual to prepare even before coming to rehearsal. Once we get together for our Thursday night rehearsal the individual parts should be gone over and be able to be put together quite easily with the full band. We typically only run through each song 2 times at rehearsal.

Promptness and attention to detail are required in this ministry.

One is expected to show up on time and completely prepared for all rehearsals and Sunday morning sound checks.
