1. What Is Heaven Like?

Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in it's time. He has also set eternity in the hearts of men...
Everything will be fair!

Isaiah 11:6-7a The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, and calf and the lion and the yearling together.

a. You get a brand new and improved body

2 Corinthians 5:4 For while we are in this tent, we grown and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.

b. In heaven we have the "No Mores"

Revelation 21:4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

2. What about the Bible?

a. The Bible is the most interesting book ever.

The Bible is the story of God's work in our world. It was written to tell us what God has done.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

It was split into two testaments because of Jesus' work. It is a historical record that we can believe.

Luke 1:1-4 Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. Therefore, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, it seemed good also to me to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus,

so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

b. The Bible is the story of God's Interaction with us.

It is the story of God's desire for a relationship with us.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

John 1:1, 14 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

c. It is the story of God's desire to redeem us.

Ephesians 2:4-5 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

The Bible is the true story of God's love for us.

3. What would you ask God...for?

a. Asking God for things...

What should our approach be when asking God for things? What might we anticipate God's response to be?

John 14:11-13 ¹¹Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves. ¹²I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. ¹³And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

b. Asking God to help us and others...

Philippians 4:6-7 ⁶Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
